Athletic Eligibility

The athletic eligibility policy as stated in the handbook is:

*“Academic Probation
A student whose academic performance indicates serious deficiencies may be placed on academic probation. Academic probation impacts a student’s ability to participate in extra-curricular activities to include school-sponsored athletics.*

Sports Eligibility

Grades will be averaged and submitted each Monday by 2:00 pm. Any student athlete having a grade percentage of 59% or lower in one or more academic or non-academic subjects will not be allowed to participate in sports for that week (Tuesday to Monday) and the Athletic Director will be notified who will, in turn, notify the coach. The entire week of ineligibility will be served. This applies to practice as well as games. The following week, every effort will be made to provide sufficient opportunity to improve the

grade. Any athlete participating in a sport while ineligible will serve an immediate in-school suspension. Prior quarter grades will be averaged with the first two weeks of the following quarter to determine eligibility. This applies only to those students who have passing grades in the prior quarter and who may have initial difficulty in the next.”

The School Board discussed this policy and agreed that it should be upheld and enforced as described.

Scrip
