### Clarification

In an effort to bring clarity and understanding to why the calendar changes were made, I'd like to offer the following explanation. I apologize that reasons were not clear when I first made the adjustments to the calendar on September 28th. As previously stated, in the future, administration will only change the calendar after the start of the

school year for cases of emergency.

November 1 (full) and 2 (3 hour): The teachers were originally scheduled to have to teach a full day and then a half day and go right into 7 and a half hours of parent/teacher conferences.
