MCHS Fun Run

The Marquette 10th Annual 5k Fun Run and 2 mile walk will take place May 6 at 8:00 am. The kids' races will begin at 8:45 with a 1 mile and a ½ mile race. The cost is \$15 for the kids races, \$20 for students, \$25 for adults and \$65 for families. Each participant will receive a microfiber short sleeved t-shirt (sponsored by OSF St. Anthony's) and Dukes donuts at the finish. There are medals in all age groups for the competitive participants but bikes and strollers are welcome as well.

Dismissal Reminders

1. At approximately 2:43/2:44, cones are put in place to signify that cars should stop moving.
2. FROM 2:44 – 2:50, STUDENTS MOVE AND CARS DO NOT.
3. FROM 2:50 – 2:55, CARS MOVE (ARE DISMISSED) AND STUDENTS DO NOT.
4. Remember your 3 Options for Pick Up:
 - a. Park in the front three sections, facing the school and wait until 2:50 to be dismissed by rows (all cars pull forward then to the left)
 - b. If you must leave quickly for an appointment, park INSIDE the roped off barricade, walk to the curb to get your child and then leave as soon as you return to your car. (No cars should be parked along the back) ***For the winter months, the buckets have been removed. The boundary should STILL be implied as being there, even though the buckets are not physically there.
 - c. Come to the "late line" pick up (2:55 – 3:00). Drive around the perimeter of the trees (just like morning drop off) up to the curb and your child gets in and you drive away.

Scrip
