

Dear Families:

It's amazing to see that the end of the school year has arrived! I want to thank you all for all the support and patience shown these past 10 months. We had successes and some challenges, yet despite all, we continued the work that has to be done in developing our Saints into young men and women who march on with Respect, Responsibility and Good Relationships. We had the opportunity to begin our work with Virtue Based Restorative Discipline Program and establishing the routine of class and faculty circles. We had great success in achieving our state and Diocesan accreditation this fall; collaborating and creating the first-ever school-wide Project-Based Learning initiative, "Mission to Mars;" produced a play and a musical involving over 40 students; continued the Young Author's program that involved close to 30 students K-8; Science Fair that involved close to 70 students K-8; A Christmas program, choir concert, Spring Sing and Art Show that involved

all 261 students in the building; sent 5 students to regional Science Fair and 2 to State; and successfully implemented a ROAR program that serviced many of our K-3 students, just to highlight a few!

### **Registration**

If you were not able to make any of the registration times during our March Open Registration, your next steps are:

1. Come to the school office and fill out/sign paperwork for next year.
2. Call the church office and make an appointment to sit down with Father Steve or one of the deacons to discuss the Family School Agreement.

3. Call the business office and make an appointment to sit down with Cathy Mahan or Peggy Hosford to discuss/pay tuition and fees.

\*It must be handled in this order. Every family (new and returning) must register in person for the new school year. Required registration fee payments for registration are: \$50 per family.
