MobyMax Individual Student Time reports:

Have your child log in to their MobyMax account. (If they can’t remember their login/password, please contact their homeroom teacher) Click on the

progress tab (the furthest one to the right) Once there, click on the “time summary” icon and it will show you the minutes at school and home that your child has accessed MobyMax.

I also recommend checking their progress by clicking on the “progress” button.
